

**Common Name: Red Eye Tree Frog**  
**Latin Name: Agalychnis callidryas**



Distribution: Central America-S. America

Natural Habitat: Tropical rain forest

Adult Size: 1" - 2.5"

Diet: Carnivore

Life Span: 4+years

### **NATURAL HABITAT**

This small frog is found among the trees deep within the tropical rain forest.

### **BEHAVIOUR**

Usually tame but frequent handling will stress the animal.

This species is nocturnal (active primarily at night).

Likes areas of dense foliage.

### **HOUSING**

When kept in captivity, use a minimum 45cmx45cmx60cm terrarium

Use full spectrum lighting 12-14 hours per day.

Use low light only, this species is mostly nocturnal.

Provide a basking area with access to a cooler zone.

### **TEMPERATURE**

Maintain day temperature range between 76-82 degrees F.

Maintain night temperature range between 72-78 degrees F.

Use low wattage heat lamp in well ventilated enclosure.

**HUMIDITY**

This species requires moderate to high levels of humidity.  
Mist the enclosure every 3-4 days to maintain humidity.

**FOOD & FEEDING**

Provide a large shallow bowl for drinking and soaking.  
Use only de-chlorinated water. Do not mist frog directly.  
This species is a carnivore.  
Always offer variety for proper nutrition.  
Dust food such as crickets with calcium & vitamins.  
Also eats wax worms and large flies.

All reptiles possess zoonotic properties so ensure you wash your hands after handling your reptile.
